Friends of the Conservation and the Chesapeake Bay,

It has been nearly a year since we last met to celebrate and support CCA Maryland's many conservation efforts. It has been a successful year for us on many fronts, and without your support, we could not be celebrating many of the following achievements and efforts:

Supporting the passage of *HB 924 – Oyster Management- Prohibited Actions*. A bill that passed Maryland's legislature, which protects 51 oyster sanctuaries from alteration or harvest. Supporting the growing Maryland oyster aquaculture industry with legislative efforts Defending against a reallocation of yellow perch away from the recreational sector, after commercial fishermen harvested more than their annual quota last winter/spring. Extensive work with CCA's Atlantic Coast Fisheries Consultants to ensure that ecosystem based management for menhaden is kept on track, and that quota increases are stopped so that menhaden populations increase and expand to historic levels and ranges Protections for forage species in federal Mid-Atlantic waters from large-scale industrial harvest.

Continued opposition to the dredging of fossil oyster shells from Man-o-War Shoal, the last great 3-D oyster bar just outside of the Patapsco River (Baltimore Harbor)

We are also very proud of the work our Habitat Committee has completed since its creation in the spring of 2016. Along with CCA's National Habitat Program, the Building Conservation Trust, CCA Maryland volunteers have orchestrated two deployments of student made reef balls to the Tilghman artificial reef site as part of our *Living Reef Action Campaign*, and built a reef in Tangier sound from nearly 400 tons of concrete pipe. Both locations will make important habitat for a number of species, and be great fishing spots.

The foundation of our reef ball building effort has been the use of our mobile reef ball-building trailer. It has traveled countless miles and to numerous elementary schools throughout Carroll County for the last year. Over 500 students have worked with CCA Maryland volunteers and teachers to roll up their sleeves, build reef balls, and learn about the importance of oysters to the bay. This spring we were proud to add our first Howard and Baltimore County schools into the program, and look forward to entering Baltimore City very soon. We are working to create leaders in conservation for the future, and continuing to see a unique trait that all Marylander's seem to have, a love for the Chesapeake Bay.

We hope you can join us on September 13<sup>th</sup> at our annual Baltimore fundraising dinner, or help support the event through a generous donation. As a non-profit grass roots organization we rely on the support of our members and gracious donors, and appreciate your consideration.
